Objective A: Analysing

Fishbowl Discussion

Analyse a passage or scene in a small-group discussion while peers observe and provide feedback.

Graphic Organiser

Compare themes, characters or literary features using a graphic organiser like a Venn diagram.

Reverse Outline

Summarise a text's structure and main ideas to examine organisation.

Annotation Challenge

Annotate a key excerpt, identifying literary devices and their effects.

Gallery Walk

Post textual analyses around the room for peer comments and insights.



Objective B: Organizing

Storyboard

Plan a written or spoken response visually with captions and images.

Outline

Peer

Review

Exchange essay outlines with a partner for feedback on clarity and structure.

Topic

Sentence

Workshop

Write and refine topic sentences to improve argument clarity.

Sequencing

Task

Arrange mixed-up paragraphs of an essay into a logical order.

Mind Map

Visually connect key ideas to plan a structured response.



Objective C: Producing Text

Creative Rewrite

Rewrite a scene or chapter from a different perspective or setting.

Monologue Performance

Write and perform a monologue for a character, demonstrating understanding of their voice.

Flash Fiction

Write a 250-word story inspired by a theme, setting, or character.

Social Media Campaign

Design a series of posts from a character's perspective to explore themes.

Genre Transformation

Convert a text into a script, poem, or speech while maintaining its key ideas.

Objective D: Using Language

Sentence Imitation

Analyze a well-written sentence and create a similar one using its structure.

Vocabulary Challenge

Use key terms from a text in new sentences or a short paragraph.

Peer Editing Stations

Rotate through editing stations focusing on grammar, transitions and diction.

Exploding a Moment

Expand a brief section of writing with detailed description and sensory details.

Spoken Word Performance

Deliver a short piece emphasising rhythm, tone and word choice.
